At the time of admission, the patient required extensive assistance for bed mobility, transferring in and out of bed and was dependent for ADLs. The patient was unable to walk or use the stairs. Following six weeks of daily participation with our therapy department, the patient became strong enough to get in and out of bed, walk 300 feet, climb 10 stairs, and complete ADLs with minimal assistance. The patient is now back at home and functioning at the same level prior to initial hospitalization.
